

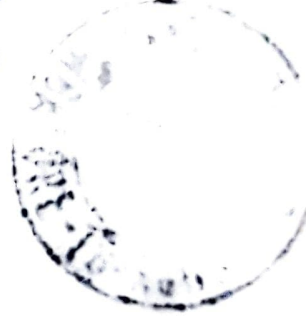

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

GREAT LAKES E-LEARNING SERVICES PVT. LTD

AND

NALLAMUTHU GOUNDER MAHALINGAM COLLEGE

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "Agreement") is made this 02nd day of March, 2021 by Nallamuthu Gounder Mahalingam College and GREAT LAKES E-LEARNING SERVICES PVT. LTD, a company incorporated in India and having its corporate office at 2nd Floor, Orchid Centre, Sec-53, Golf course road, Gurgaon, India 122002 (hereafter referred to as "GREAT LEARNING") and Nallamuthu Gounder Mahalingam College, an educational institution set up in India and having its registered office at 90, Palghat Road, Pollachi, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, India 642001 (hereinafter referred to as "INSTITUTE").

PURPOSE

That Great Learning intends to assist universities and colleges deliver high quality and impactful online and blended learning by providing access to its Courses and the use of its proprietary end to end cloud based solution, Olympus Digital Campus (hereinafter "Platform") to create a seamless student, faculty and Administration (hereinafter "User") experience that ensures excellent learning outcomes.

That the Institute intends to utilise the Courses offered by Great Learning along with the Platform in providing an online and blended learning experience for students and faculty.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and conditions set forth in this Agreement, Great Learning and Institute (individually, the "Party" and collectively, the "Parties") agree as follows:

I. OBLIGATIONS:

A. Great Learning will

2. This Agreement may be terminated with or without cause by providing written notice to the other party atleast thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of termination.
3. In the event of expiry or termination of this Agreement, the Institute shall promptly pay to Great Learning, all amounts due and payable to Great Learning under this Agreement or otherwise for the Courses or the Platform.

III. CONFIDENTIALITY AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

2. This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the Parties with respect to the Relationship and may be modified only by a written agreement signed by each Party.



Annexure 1:

Program Brief:

India has one of the largest as well as the youngest workforce in the world. This is potentially one of the most integral factors that can make the country a global economic giant. But the current gap between skills required by the industry and the skill level of the incoming/existing workforce is making the situation that could potentially head towards disaster with a rise in unemployment despite availability of jobs as well as steady enrollment in higher studies.

To mitigate this, the proposed program aims to bridge the skill gap by providing students from tier 2/3 institutes, typically from underserved communities, with future skills that bring up their employability index. The program proposes to impart future skills such as cognitive thinking, problem-solving, effective communication, teamwork, etc. along with IR 4.0 skills centered around Data Analytics and Cloud Computing ensuring current career readiness along with future readiness. Duration: March 2023 to August 2023

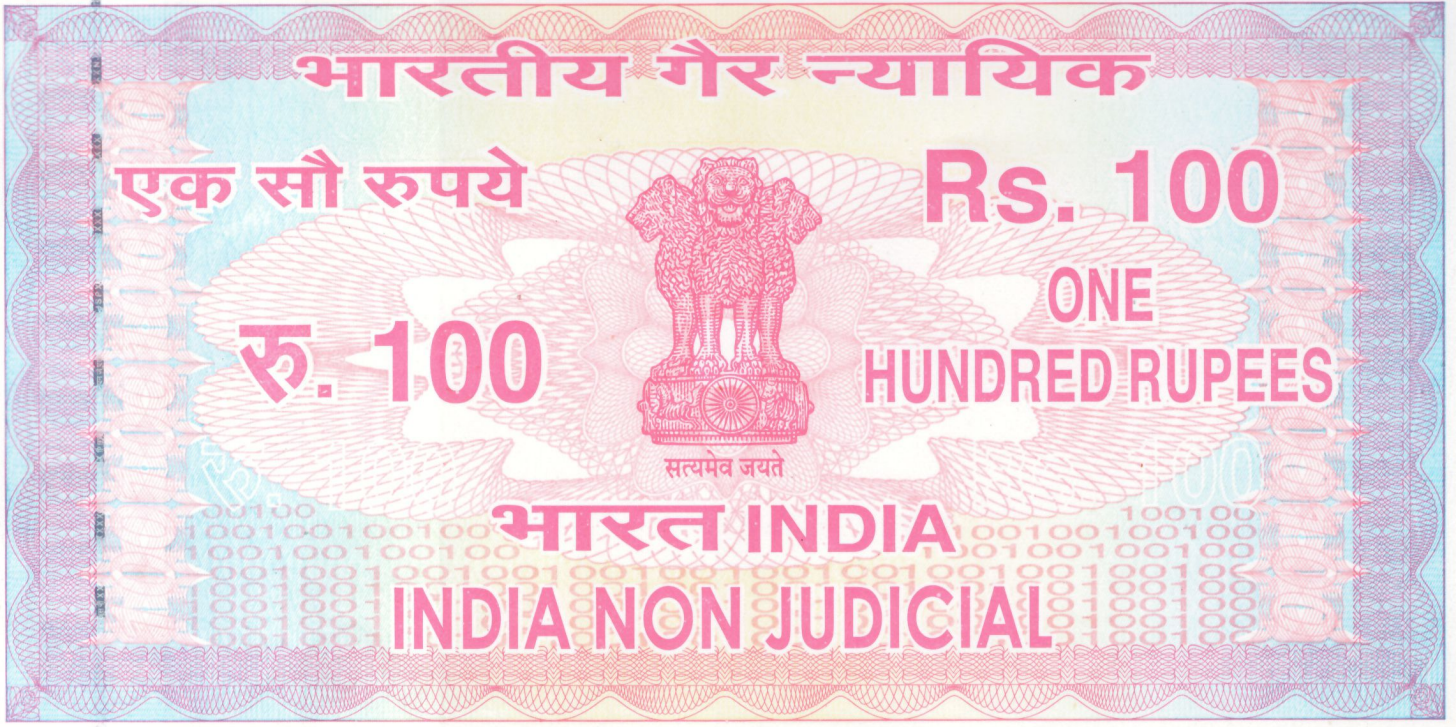
Target number of learners: In the state of Telangana, Tamil Nadu & Karnataka the program aims to train 1500 students from Engineering and /or Sciences background



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Legal Effect, Legal Approvals




