#### **PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE**

Nallamuthu Gounder Mahalingam College is engaged to provide facilities for higher education for students from high schools of Pollachi and Udumalpet Taluks started as “Pollachi Kalvi Kazhagam” in the year 1957 under the Presidentship of Shri S.P. Nallamuthu Gounder and the Secretaryship of Arutchelvar Dr. N. Mahalingam.

For over 65 years, NGM is providing quality education to the youth has been growing consistently spreading its wings far and wide to offer a variety of educational programmes under one roof with the following Vision and Mission.

#### **Vision**

Our dream is to make the College an institution of excellence at the national level by imparting quality education of global standards to make students academically superior, socially committed, ethically strong, spiritually evolved and culturally rich citizens to contribute to the holistic development of the self and society.

#### **Mission**

Training students to become role models in academic arena by strengthening infrastructure, upgrading curriculum, developing faculty, augmenting extension services and imparting quality education through an enlightened management and committed faculty who ensure knowledge transfer, instil research aptitude and infuse ethical and cultural values to transform students into disciplined citizens in order to improve quality of life.

#### **Programmes Offered**

NGM is offering 39 UG programmes, 12 PG Programmes, 14 M.Phil., and 13 Ph.D., Programmes in both Aided and Self Financing Streams with 5369 students, 236 faculty, 81 Non-teaching staff. The institution also host Eight Certificate Courses, Two Diploma Courses and 46 Value added courses.

During the year 2021-2022, newly introduced 3 UG Courses, B.Sc Computer Science with AI and ML , B.Sc Computer Science with Data Analytics and Bachelor of Social Work.

#### **ACADEMIC PROGRESS**

##### **Curricular Aspects**

During the year 2021-2022 the Board of studies meeting was conducted on

20.05.2022 and 39 programmes syllabus revision was carried out and 916 courses have the focus with employability / entrepreneurship/skill development is being offered by the institution. 73 new courses introduced during the year 2021-2022 and 100% of programmes in which CBCS elective course system has been implemented. 3583 of students enrolled in the value added courses by the institution and 1739 of students have undertaken field projects / internships / student projects.

NGM College is one of the foremost institutions which promote education to rural students in and around Pollachi. It has expanded its branches of knowledge through Core, Interdisciplinary, Foundation, Diploma, Value-based Education, and Value-added Courses. The Curricula is designed based on Choice Based Credit System and Outcome Based Education focusing on Employability, Skill Development, and Entrepreneurship which is updated once a year to suit the needs of the stakeholders.

In the year 2021-2022, the various courses offered by the institution focus on the regional, national, and global value as reflected in POs, and PSOs. The Course Objectives (COs) are Agricultural Marketing Management, Tourism Marketing, Vallalar Kotpadukalum, Gandhiyamum, Herbal Technology, Organic and Inorganic Chemistry, Language Skills for Enhancing Employability, Business Ethics, Online Trading, Consumer Affairs, Intellectual Property Rights, Python Programming, Mobile Application Development, Internet of Things, Open Source Methodologies, Artificial Intelligence, Embedded System, Cloud, and Big Data Analytics, Guidance and Counseling, Global Business Environment and Android Programming. To develop the mental strength of the students, Human Excellence provides Personal, Family, Professional, Social, National, and Global Values and Sky Yoga Practice to the students every semester. Certificate Courses on Uzhavu Bharatham and Maniyiyal Magathuvam and Value added courses are being offered.

The subjects like Professional Ethics, Gender, Environment and Sustainability, and Human Values are also included in the curriculum. The College encourages Professional Ethics through book publications and courses like Business Ethics, Auditing and Assurance, Personality Development Skills, Guidance and Counseling, Corporate Social Responsibility and Social Marketing, E-commerce and Cyber Security, Intellectual Property rights, and related to Professional ethics. To create awareness among the students to uplift agriculture, a certificate course is offered by the college. Importance is given to Gender studies in the form of a certificate course including - Women Studies, Fundamentals of Entrepreneurship, and Entrepreneurship Development Program.

The primary focus lies on Human Values. The courses offered related to Human

Values are Human Rights, Human Rights in India, and International HRM. To create awareness among the student on Environment and Sustainability, the college offer courses like Green Marketing, Disaster Management, Ecology and Phytogeography, Forestry, and Green Nano Chemistry. The college has taken a leading role in integrating extension activity programmes into the regular schedule. AIDS awareness, Environment conservation, International Women’s Day, Human Rights Rally, and Interdepartmental Cultural Competitions for Women, are some of the programmes organized and successfully completed.

## **Teaching-Learning and Evaluation**

### **Teacher Quality**

236 full time teachers,164 are with Ph.D, 200 teachers are with M. Phil 236 teachers are with PG Degree and 40 teachers have cleared SET/SLET and 30 teachers have cleared NET Examination. The average teaching experience of the teachers in the college is 5 years.

### **Assesses students’ learning levels**

The institution assesses the learning level of the students by adopting different practices. Orientation programme and induction programs are organized both at the college and department levels. Bridge course is conducted for first year undergraduate students for a week to develop confidence level, communication level and to impart subject knowledge in the relevant discipline. Their learning level would be assessed based on the test conducted at the end of the bridge course combined with their +2 marks. On the basis of students profile the faculty identifies slow learners and advanced learners in their classes and assign activities accordingly. Summer Internships, NPTEL/SWAYAM/ IIT Spoken tutorial/MOOC, Mock test for CA/CMA Foundation and Global Talent Track on Corporate Readiness Program in Commerce discipline are the activities done for

advanced learners. Remedial classes were conducted for slow learners. Questions that needed special attention were revised for slow learners

### **Students Centric Methods:**

College provides an effective platform for students to develop cutting-edge skills, knowledge, attitudes, and values that will shape their behavior in the right direction. All departments conduct innovative programs that stimulate students' creative abilities while also providing a platform for them to hone their problem-solving skills and ensure participatory learning. Students are encouraged to compete at both the intercollegiate and national levels. The institute focuses on student-centered methods of enhancing students' lifelong learning skills. Field trips were arranged by the faculty. The departments plan and organize industrial visits for students to learn about industrial work culture.

### **Utility of ICT enable tools**

The Global Pandemic Situation has posed an array of challenges to the structure and procedure of the institutions. With the Faculty members, smartness challenges are converted to opportunities to make better use of ICT-enabled Remote Classrooms through conferencing platforms such as ZOOM, Microsoft Teams, and Google Meet along with Smart Boards and LCD Projectors which are in existence. Kahoot, Hot Potatoes, and Testmoz are used to test the competency of the students. Virtual Labs enable the students and scholars to simulate laboratory conditions. Students are being encouraged to learn new courses via MOOC and SWAYAM Platforms. CAMU-ERP actively supports conducting exams online

### **Evaluation process and reforms:**

Continuous Internal Assessment test was conducted (CIA) and End of Semester Examinations (ESE) were conducted through online mode as mandated by the Bharathiyar University in compliance with the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP).The Examination procedures and guidelines were informed to the teaching staff and the students through online mode. Semester Examinations during the academic year was conducted online mode with 99.08% results. Results were published through College Website.

### **Research, Innovation and Extension**

NGM has a healthy ecosystem for the transfer of knowledge and to foster innovations. The curricular, extra-curricular and extended activities of the college are designed to instill entrepreneurship skills along with subject knowledge and with a research orientation. The departments promote entrepreneurship through skill based, and value-added courses.

The IIC at NGM college provides students with an open space to come up with new ideas and collaborate with others to bring them to life. It's a nurturing environment where students can experiment and create without fear of failures or judgment.

An inauguration of Rural Entrepreneurship Development Cell and Workshop on Red Cell Action Plan Approved by MGNCRE. - Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Hyderabad, Government of India and Organized one day workshop on "Atmanirbhar Bharat through Experiential Learning, Internship, Apprenticeship and Entrepreneurship" on 19th March 2021, by Nallamuthu Gounder Mahalingam College, Pollachi, in collaboration with Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Hyderabad, Government of India and a student volunteer teams was organized to work in the areas of Hospital Management, Non-Hospital Management, Support to Covid affected families, Medical Supplies, Psychological support to Covid patients and their family members as a part of Beat Covid Campaign initiative of Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India, Hyderabad. Frequent training is given to the students to promote their sales and marketing skills through outside entrepreneur's stall and students stall. The college is a member in EDII, Government of Tamil Nadu, under Bharathiar University hub. Our institution is one of the best spoke institutions in the hub. And we have received funds from EDII for giving training to the students.

236 full time teachers are with PhD and guiding 160 Ph.D., and M.Phil Scholars. During the year 110 PhDs awarded and 120 M.Phil. awarded under various disciplines.

166 Research articles published in UGC / SCOPUS / Conferences / Peer Reviewed Journals.80 papers presented in seminars / conferences.73 Number of books and chapters in edited volumes / books published by the faculty members.21 faculty members are awarded Seed Money with a tune of Rs.400000.

An amount of Rs.650000 grants received from Government and non-governmental agencies for research projects from UGC / ICSSR / TNSCST.48 Workshops conducted on Research Methodology / IPR, Entrepreneurship and Skills development. The amount of Rs. 75255 generated from consultancy. 60 Extension activities carried out the college and 2 awards and recognition received by the institution. 46 value-added courses conducted for imparting transferable and life skills offered during the year and 3583 students registered during the year.

16 Extension and outreach programs conducted by NSS / NCC/Red Cross / YRC and 800 students participated in extension activities. 4 number of collaborative activities done for research / Faculty exchange. 30 functional MoUs with institutions.

### **Infrastructure Facilities**

The Library is fully computerized with open access to all. Integrated Library Management System is used. Internet facility is provided for the registered users. Intranet – OPAC can be viewed in the library. OPAC provides details about Books, Periodicals, and Thesis dissertations. The digital library gives access to major E-resources of (Subscribed) such as NLIST, DELNET online, and NDL. There are more than 1000 academic-related links to access through the Digital library and also access open access journals. The Bar-coded ID card is provided for entry to the users. The entry of the users is documented by a scanner at the entrance of the library.

24. World Intellectual Property Day – 21.04.2022

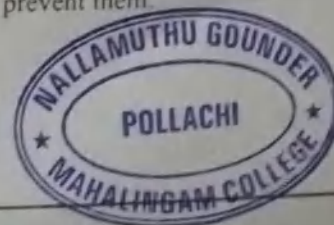
