Every academic year, in the months of April and November, the evaluations of the curriculum and syllabi are documented. Data on syllabus development and overall Programme experience are incorporated into the curriculum investigation. The review of the current curriculum in-light of student, industry, and job placement demands becomes the first step in developing curricula for various Programmes.

The process of curriculum development and revision involves a thorough and extensive evaluation of the current curriculum, which must go through several stages with the active participation of students, teachers, and academic experts from other institutions.

Students submit feedback on the curriculum for each course, and this feedback is collected and properly taken into account when assessing the curriculum. At the end of every academic year, feedback from students is collected through a questionnaire template created by the ERP. At the end of the semester, online feedback is gathered from the Students through the ERP. The Curriculum Development Cell reviews the feedback of each faculty member for all of the courses they have taught during the session.

The appropriate established curriculum review committee of the institution, which typically meets at the end of every semester, evaluates the feedback collected from all stakeholders.
